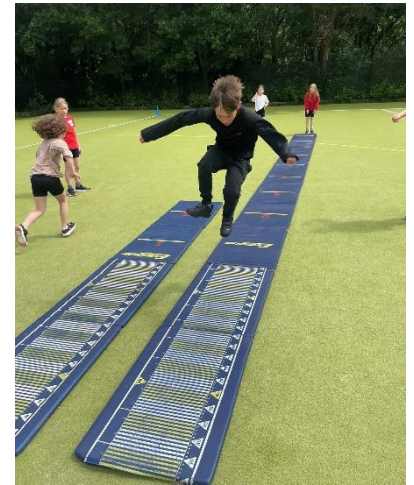
What an excellent term for PE and Sport at Buxton Junior School!

Year 6 'Quad Kids' Athletics High Peak Final

Our Year 6 'Quad Kids' Team travelled to Chapel High School to take part in the Quad Kids Athletics High Peak Final after qualifying for a place in the Buxton Schools competition at the end of last term. Each child took part in four athletic events: standing long jump, 100m sprint, howler javelin and a tough 600m run. All ten children pushed themselves in each event, really showing the BJS values and doing the school proud.



Our second group of children took part alongside a team of our Year 5 children. They all took part in running, jumping and throwing activities and earned points for their team at each event. Well done everyone!

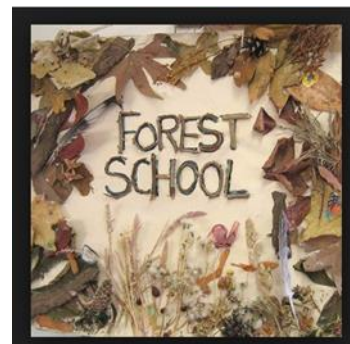


Derbyshire Forest Games
