## Online Safety

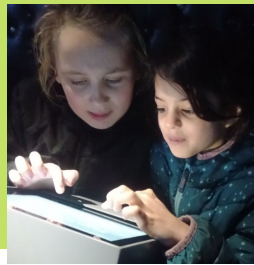

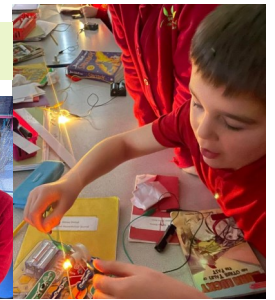

## Parking on Mosley Road

Please could I ask you to ensure you always park safely and courteously near school at the beginning and end of the day. Please do not park too close to the corner of Compton Road. We have had some very near misses recently with children nearly being knocked over as they try to cross. I have asked the PCSOs to attend again to help direct parking but obviously they cannot be there every day so it is upon us as a school community to do the right thing.

Please do not park on the grass verges nor on the white lines near the gates nor over any dropped kerbs or in front of driveways. I receive frequent complaints from local residents about this.

Please do not park in the turning area in front of the police house as this makes it impossible for people to turn around.
